#### Hanson's Class Substitute Lesson plan for 29 February – 4 March 2016

Please set up the laptops on the desks from the COWS laptop cart.

## **End of Day Procedures:**

- 1. Insure all laptops are shut down, disconnected, and locked up.
- 2. You will need to place the laptops in the cart there will be 16 in the cart. Then lock it up and put the key in my middle desk drawer.
- 3. Insure that the Smartboard Speaker switch is turned off press to the left, and it is located beneath the right speaker.
- 4. Insure my Smartboard is turned off.
- 5. Insure my phone is in the charger on the desk by the flag.
- 13. At the end of class, please insure all the chairs are pushed in, the 3 powerstrips are switched off, and insure the door is closed.
